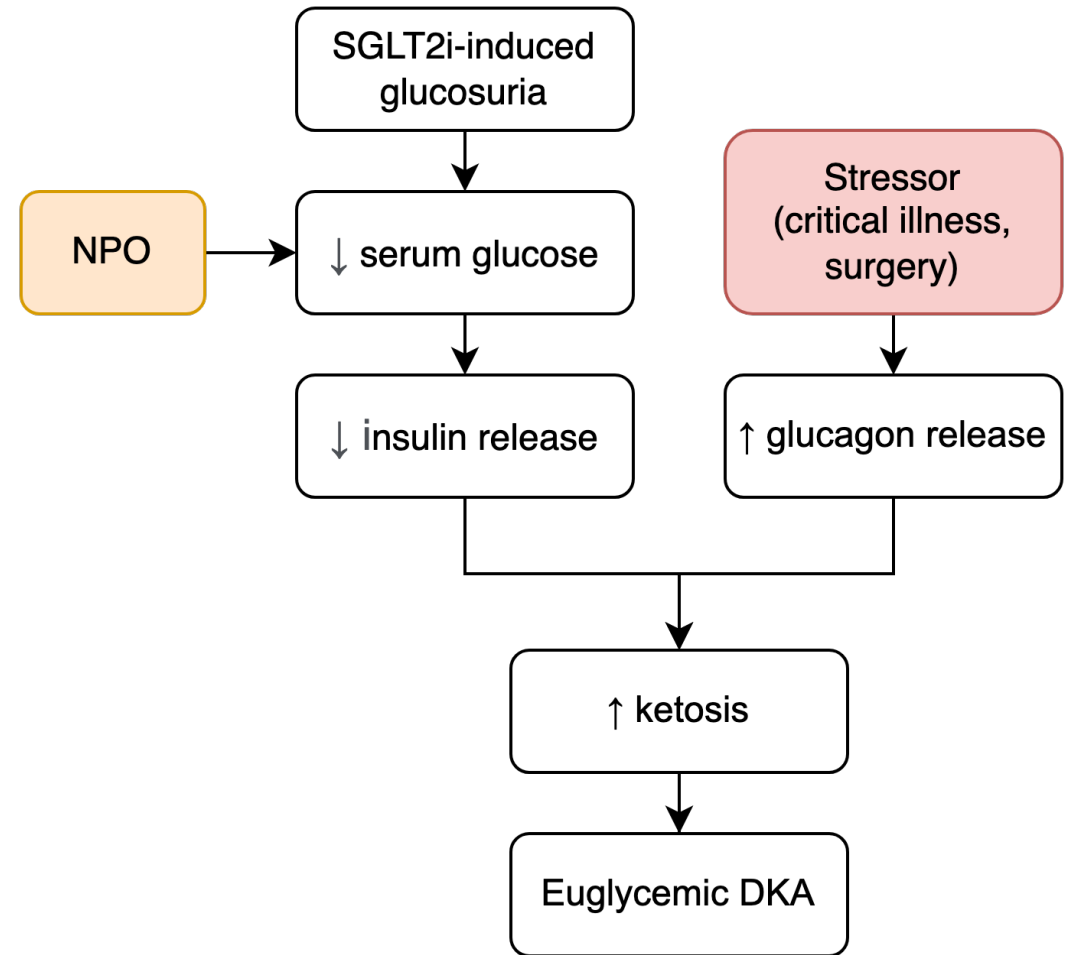


SGLT2i-induced Euglycemic DKA

SGLT2 inhibitors promote glucosuria by inhibiting Na-Glucose co-transporter in the nephron

SGLT2 inhibitors should be stopped pre-operatively to avoid euglycemic DKA (anywhere from 3-7 days)

Consider stopping SGLT2 inhibitors if your patient is NPO
