

LPS vs Probate Conservatorship

DPOA information can be found in Advanced Directives, living wills, or other legal documents

DPOAs specifically have to be assigned for healthcare and/or finances

Capacity to assign a DPOA should be specifically assessed if no DPOA is assigned

	Lanterman-Petris- Short (LPS)	Probate
Indication	Psychiatric conditions	Non-psychiatric conditions (e.g., dementia)
Psychiatric medical decisions	Conservator may give consent for psychiatric medications	Conservator may <u>not</u> give consent for psychiatric medications unless given authority by the court to treat dementia
Non-psychiatric medical decisions	Must be granted by the court	Conservator may give consent for medical decisions
Finances (conservator of the estate)	Conservator rarely controls finances; the Public Guardian acts as payee	Conservator can make decisions about finances
Term	One year	Indefinite
